Lalezar is the poetic Ottoman word for a tulip garden, that most Ottoman of flowers. An Anatolian mountain wildflower, the tulip craze in the early 1700s brought both fame and fortune to the Ottomans as Dutch importers brought the bulbs to Europe, bulbs which at their height were worth more than gold. The tulip, with the carnation, is the iconic symbol of the Ottomans, and the flower symbol of their imperial city, Istanbul. Our richly decorative Lalezar tile is painted with raised texture.

Accent tiles do not create repeating designs, and are excellent as accents in kitchen backsplashes, interspersed on bathroom walls, etc.

Iznik tiles are one of the most recognizable of all Ottoman arts. The iconic tiles are named after their production center in Iznik – ancient Nicaea, of the Nicaean Code – which lies on the eastern shore of the Marmara Sea.

The height of Iznik tiles in both design and technique was the 16th century, during the height of the Ottoman Empire. Our handmade tiles maintain this artistic legacy and support contemporary artisans in Turkey.

Iznik tiles are for wall and accent use. Suitable for use in wet areas such bathrooms and kitchens. Not for use as flooring. Small cracks in the glaze, minor variations in color, and small slips of the brush are hallmarks of the process and are not flaws.
